We're still reflecting with amazement on the results of the [One Million Bones Challenge](#): First, more than 1,500 teams of students, educators, artists and activists from every state in the U.S. and [31 countries](#) made 1,000,000 bones—all laid on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. on June 6. Secondly, these efforts raised a total of \$500,000, because each bone generated a donation from the [Bezos Family Foundation](#) for CARE's work in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Somalia.
